## Aircraft Pre-Use Checklist

Safety is the paramount consideration in all Agency aircraft operations.

## **Planning Requirements**

- 1. Has the flight / operation been approved?
- 2. All aircraft flights / operations shall be conducted as per the DSE Air Operations Manual.
- 3. All aspects of the conduct of any aircraft flight must be properly planned including the identification of hazards.
- An accredited Agency aviation person must be involved in the planning of an aircraft flight if not actually participating.
- 5. The pilot shall be briefed on the mission prior to a flight commencing.
- Flight Following and flight notification procedures are mandatory for any aircraft flight.
- A record of the pilot and passengers carried must be available on the ground at all times any aircraft is flying.
- 8. Have you briefed the nominated responsible person with regard Flight Following procedures?

### **Safety Requirements**

- Mandatory PPE requirements exist for Agency personnel conducting any aircraft flight.
- All Agency personnel shall receive an aircraft safety brief before departure.
- 3. Minimum safety equipment requirements exist for all contract and CWN aircraft.
- Dangerous Goods carried during a flight must be declared and labeled as per Agency procedures.

More detailed information is contained in the DSE Air Operations Manual or can be obtained from State Aircraft Unit personnel.

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### Aircraft Pre-Use Checklist

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### Aircraft / Pilot Requirements

- Any aircraft used for Agency flights must be registered on the Call When Needed (CWN) register with the State Aircraft Unit or be a State Fleet aircraft.
- All registered CWN companies must have an Air Operators Certificate registered for charter or airwork operations depending on the operations to be conducted.
- All CWN aircraft operators must hold an insurance policy to cover liability to passengers and third parties to a combined single limit of at least \$10 Million.
- 4. Only helicopters powered by turbine engines are to be used for Agency operations.
- Use of "Ultra Light Aircraft", balloons, hang gliders, gliders, gyrocopters etc. for Agency operations is not permitted.
- 6. All State Fleet or CWN pilots must hold a commercial pilots license and meet minimum total hours and hours on type.
- Restricted category aircraft cannot be used to transport Agency personnel.
- Only twin engine helicopters or single engine helicopters fitted with floats can work offshore more than 5km – life vests are mandatory.
- Any aircraft conducting an Agency operation must carry at least one operating agency radio with a hard wired aerial – pre -flight radio checks are mandatory.

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
